

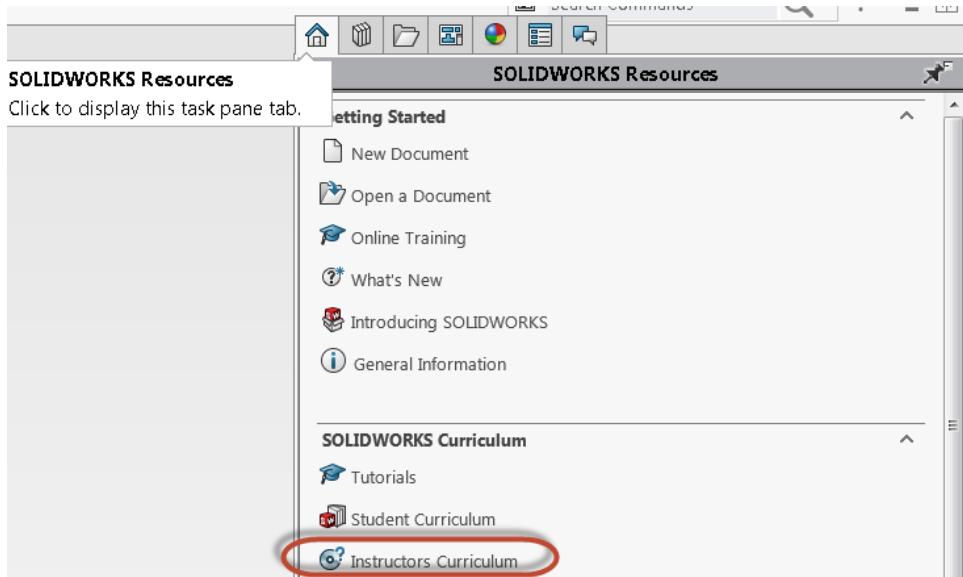


## Curriculum Location SOLIDWORKS 2018-2019

### INSTRUCTORS CURRICULUM



1. Launch SOLIDWORKS Education Edition 2018-2019. Go to the SOLIDWORKS Resources Task Pane, under SOLIDWORKS Curriculum, select "Instructors Curriculum".




2. You will be directed to the **SOLIDWORKS Education Edition 2018-2019** section on [www.solidworks.com](http://www.solidworks.com). Scroll down to the curriculum and lessons section. Select the curriculum you would like to download.

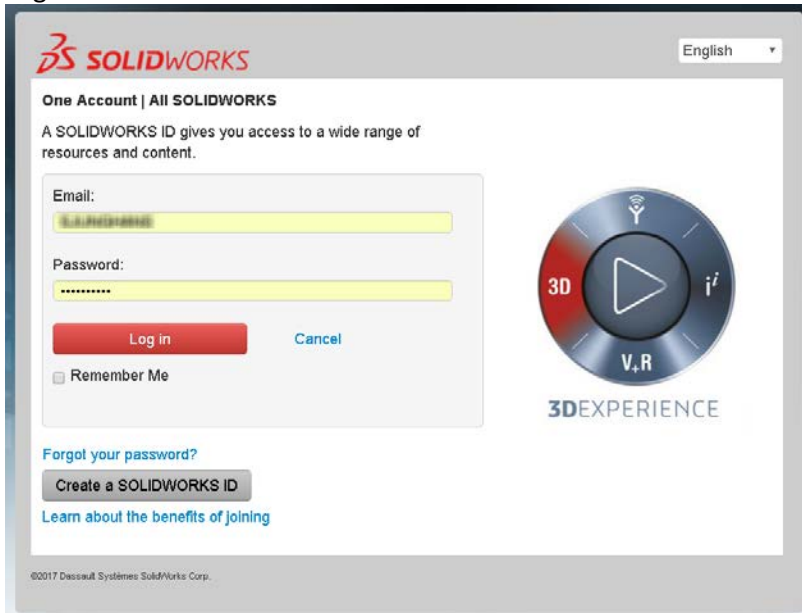

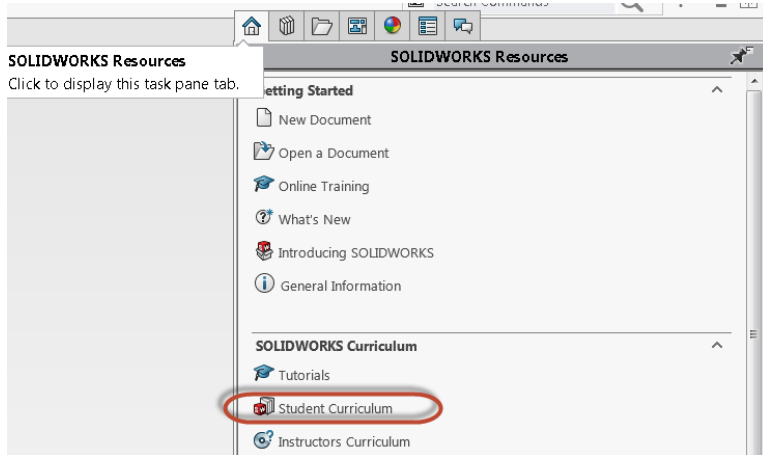
5. After a successful login, you will see the screen below. Under the **Download** section, select the curriculum you would like to download. A link to the model files is located in the curriculum PDF.
